[1] The Board is ready to commence proceeding PT25-03 SOCAN Tariff 1.B – Non-Commercial Radio other than the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (2022-2027) to consider the following proposed tariffs (the “Proposed Tariffs”):

- SOCAN Tariff 1.B – Non-Commercial Radio other than the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (2022-2024)
- SOCAN Tariff 1.B – Radio – Non-Commercial Radio other than the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation (2025-2027)
