UNLOCATABLE COPYRIGHT OWNER

Non-exclusive licence issued to The Estate Condominium Board, Calgary, Alberta, authorizing the reproduction of mechanical design drawings

Pursuant to the provisions of subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*, the Copyright Board grants a licence to The Estate Condominium Board as follows:

- (1) The licence authorizes the reproduction of one copy – for purposes of a Reserve Fund Study only – of the mechanical design drawings for the property located at 720 – 13th Avenue SW, City of Calgary, Province of Alberta, created by K. Michie, P.Eng in 1982.

The issuance of the licence does not release the applicant from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered by this licence.

- (2) The licence expires on December 31, 2003. The authorized reproduction must therefore be completed by that date.
- (3) The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.
- (4) The applicant will pay the sum of \$25 to any person who establishes, before December 31, 2008, ownership of the copyright in the work covered by this licence.
- (5) The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the applicant's filing with the Board his undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (4) above
