**UNLOCATABLE COPYRIGHT OWNER**

**Non-exclusive licence issued to Saxby & Pokorny Architects, Calgary, Alberta, authorizing the reproduction of mechanical and electrical plans**

Pursuant to the provisions of subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*, the Copyright Board grants a licence to Saxby & Pokorny Architects, as follows:

- (1) The licence authorizes the reproduction of two copies – for renovation purposes only – of the mechanical and electrical plans designed in 1981 by Larry W.T. Tang, Continental Design Inc., for the property located at 800 Macleod Trail S.E. in the City of Calgary, Province of Alberta.

The issuance of the licence does not release the licensee from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered in this licence.

- (2) The licence expires on December 31, 2005. The authorized reproduction must therefore be completed by that date.
- (3) The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.
- (4) The licensee will pay the sum of \$50 to any person who establishes, before December 31, 2010, ownership of the copyright in the work covered in this licence.
- (5) The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the licensee filing with the Board their undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (4) above.
