UNLOCATABLE COPYRIGHT OWNERS

Non-exclusive licence issued to Hilda M. Dueck for the reproduction of two prints

Pursuant to the provisions of section 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*, the Copyright Board grants a licence to Hilda M. Dueck as follows:

- (1) The licence authorizes the reproduction of prints of Elwin (or Edwin) Edwards' paintings "A June Morning" and "September Eve" published by The Artistic Publishing Company (year of publication unknown).

A single copy of each of the works shall be reproduced.

- (2) The licence expires on December 31, 2000. The authorized reproduction must therefore be completed by that date.
- (3) The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.
- (4) Hilda M. Dueck will reimburse the sum of \$25 for each of the works to any person who establishes, before December 31, 2005, ownership of the copyright in the works covered by this licence.
- (5) The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the applicant's filing with the Board her undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (4) above.
