Non-exclusive licence issued to Louise Bienvenue, Sherbrooke, Quebec, pursuant to subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*

[1] The licence authorizes the reproduction and communication to the public by telecommunication, including the making available to the public, of the first page of the article *Dans notre histoire, La Femme canadienne française : Almanach de la Langue Française*, Éditions Albert Lévesque (1936), in the book *Marie-Claire Daveluy : une femme à la table des historiens (1880-1968)*, Presses de l'Université Laval, to be published in 2025.

[2] The licence expires on April 2, 2040.

[3] The issuance of the licence does not release the licensee from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered by this licence.

[4] The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.

[5] The licensee will pay the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25) to anybody who establishes, before April 2, 2045, ownership of the copyright in the work covered in this licence.

[6] The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the licensee filing with the Board a notice of undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (5).
