Non-exclusive licence issued to Larisa Segida, Winnipeg, Manitoba, pursuant to subsection 77(1) of the *Copyright Act*

[1] The licence authorizes the licensee to produce, reproduce, perform, including communicate to the public by telecommunication, and publish a Russian translation of the book “By Grand Central Station I Sat Down and Wept” by Elizabeth Smart (1945).

[2] The licence authorizes 5000 copies.

[3] The licence expires on August 13, 2040.

[4] The issuance of the licence does not release the licensee from the obligation to obtain permission for any other use not covered by this licence.

[5] The licence is non-exclusive and valid only in Canada. For other countries, it is the law of that country that applies.

[6] The licensee will pay the sum of 10% of income earned from the uses authorized in the licence to anybody who establishes, before August 13, 2045, ownership of the copyright in the work covered in this licence.

[7] The coming into force of this licence is conditional on the licensee filing with the Board a notice of undertaking to comply with the conditions set out in paragraph (6).
